DNA Testing and/or Genealogy Search Sites

- FamilySearch.org – no-cost document searching / information about, but no DNA testing.
The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints
- MyHeritage.org – DNA testing or upload of results / family tree / subscription options.
Private company founded in Israel. Extensive research materials for all people.
- ancestry.com – free to build/share trees / one-time cost for DNA / subscription required for research.
Private online company based in Utah - owns some sites listed here.
- 23andme.com - DNA with focus on health results; chromosome matching.
Private company founded in U.S
- GEDmatch.com – Free upload of DNA /search matches/ chromosome matching / interesting data set comparisons / low-cost monthly fee for extra features. Must opt in to be included in police searches.
